BACKGROUND

The Global Leprosy Strategy 2021–2030 aims to accelerate progress towards the goal of zero leprosy—zero disease, zero disability, and zero stigma and discrimination—and is aligned with the 2021–2030 road map for neglected tropical diseases (NTDs). This road map identifies leprosy as one of the diseases targeted for elimination by interrupting transmission. Major global leprosy stakeholders, including the WHO's Global Leprosy Program (GLP–WHO), the International Federation of Anti-Leprosy Associations (ILEP), various NGOs, national leprosy societies, and government agencies, participate in the International Leprosy Congress, which is held every three years. At the 21st ILC in Hyderabad, India, the responsibility for hosting the next Congress was handed over to Prof. M. Yulianto Listiawan, MD, Ph.D., FINSDV, FAADV of Indonesia during the closing plenary. The 22nd ILC will take place in 2025 in Bali, Indonesia.

In 2022, 54 countries reported zero new leprosy cases, 79 reported fewer than 100, 33 reported 101–1,000 cases, and 12 countries reported 1,001–10,000 cases. Brazil, India, and Indonesia each reported over 10,000 new cases, accounting for 78.1% of global cases. All three countries saw an increase in new case detection compared to the previous year: Brazil by 7.2%, Indonesia by 13.3%, and India by 37.7%. Indonesia ranks third globally in leprosy cases, with the disease still posing a public health challenge in several provinces. As of 2022, 7 provinces and 113 regencies/cities in Indonesia have not achieved leprosy elimination, with a prevalence exceeding 1 case per 10,000 population. This presents a significant opportunity for Indonesia's leprosy control program to learn from other countries and collaborate with international organizations.

The theme of the 22nd ILC is "Towards a World with Zero Leprosy." Support from WHO Indonesia and the National Leprosy Control Program under the Ministry of Health is crucial for the success of this Congress, especially as it is the first time the ILC will be held in Indonesia. This scientific meeting will play a pivotal role in addressing and systematically eradicating this global health issue, as reflected in the theme. The ILC is jointly organized by the Indonesian Society of Dermatology and Venereology (INSDV), Netherlands Leprosy Relief (NLR) Indonesia, and the National Leprosy Control Program of the Ministry of Health, under the auspices of the International Leprosy Association (ILA).

GENERAL OBJECTIVE

To foster and facilitate collaboration among individuals of all nationalities involved in leprosy work and to coordinate their efforts.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE

- 1. To facilitate the dissemination of knowledge about leprosy and its control.
- 2. To support global anti-leprosy campaigns.
- 3. To publish scientific journals of leprosy.

EXPECTED OUTPUT

The abstract book was indexed, and the abstracts were given an ISSN (International Standard Serial Number) for citation. Papers were invited under six main topics: Clinical Aspects, Epidemiology and Control, Social Aspects, Lab Aspects, Disability and Rehabilitation, and Therapeutics.

PARTICIPANTS
